### Here is some information from UNICEF.

How can I speak to my children about the Coronavirus? Here are some tips:

Listen first. Does your child want to talk about it? Take their lead.

Stick to the facts. It's important to be honest with your child. Remember the risks currently are low in the UK. Be part of the solution. Talk to your child about what they can do, such as covering their nose and mouth when coughing or sneezing and washing their hands regularly with soap and water.

Be mindful. Remember children can pick up on your response to the news. Stay calm and informed.

Act on advice. People have taken swift action to control the virus. Follow the advice of the UK government.
