

We would like to welcome you all back to nursery, either virtually or in nursery. We hope you had a wonderful, healthy and safe holiday break. Sadly, the start of our New Year has presented us with further worries. In response to our Risk Assessment, we are prioritising on site provision for children with SEND, Keyworkers and family vulnerabilities.

Many of you have shared that you would prefer for your child to remain at home currently. This will not affect your child's place at nursery. We will continue to make contact and provide daily online, remote learning activities via Tapestry.

Keyworkers will continue to be in contact with all families through weekly telephone calls and Tapestry. We are doing all that we possibly can to include as many children as we can in nursery safely. If you would like to your child to access on site provision, please inform your child's keyworker during weekly wellbeing calls or phone the school office on 0121 464 2034. We would need to know in advance to enable us to plan to keep the children safely within family group bubbles, with familiar staff.

To lower risks and reduce congestion, we have had to amend start and end times and some session times. Please see details on the back of this page for information about your child's key group.

Can we remind all parents and carers to wear a mask when entering the nursery gates. This is to protect yourselves, other parents and staff members. For further information about changes please look at our website and click the COVID 19 tab.
