Please join us on Tuesday 19th & Thursday 21st September 2023 from 9am to 9.30am for a parent workshop to find out more information about nursery and ask any questions.

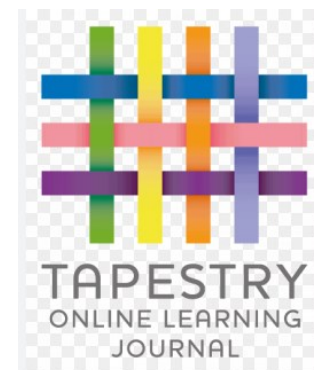

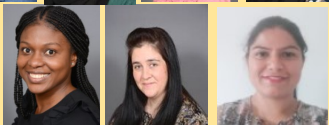

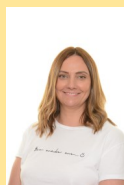
